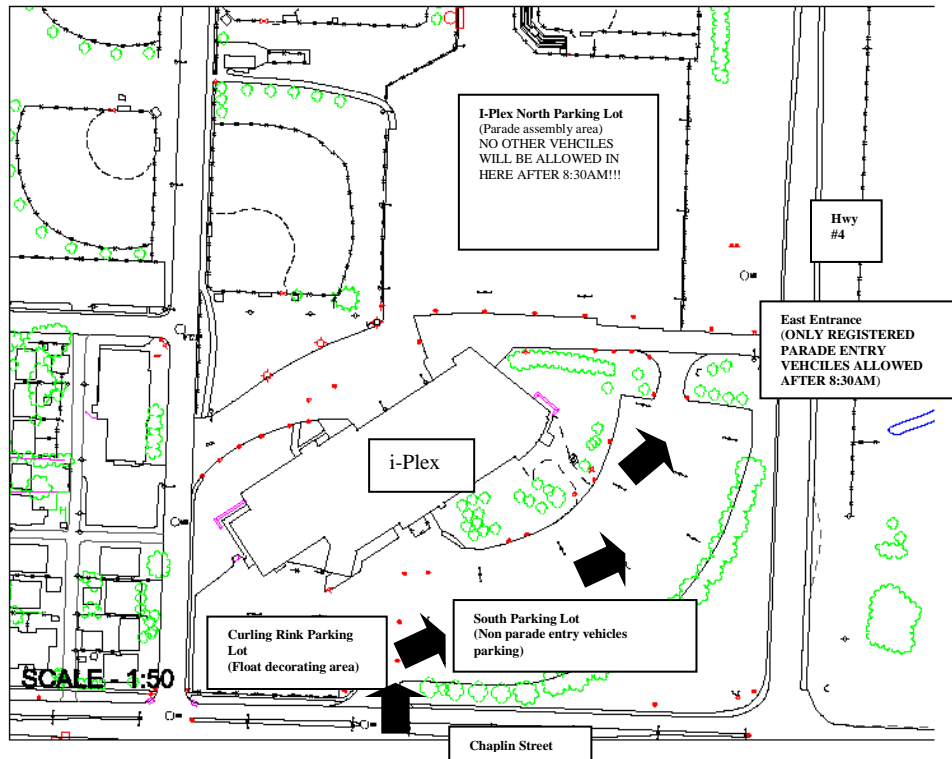

**SWIFT CURRENT AGRICULTURAL & EXHIBITION ASSOCIATION  
2017 PARADE INFORMATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. The parade assembly area is located in the Credit Union i-plex North parking lot. Floats and other parade entries **MUST** enter at the Main entrance of the Credit Union i-plex parking lot (Chaplin Street) and then head over to the East entrance of the parking lot (Hwy #4). Attendants will be present to direct you to your designated location.
2. Entries for judging must be in position at the Credit Union i-plex North parking lot by 7:45 a.m., July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017. Late arrivals will not be judged.
3. The parade will commence at 10:00 a.m. **SHARP**.
4. If you would like to distribute promotional materials, candy, balloons, or other treats along the parade route, persons walking beside your entry must hand deliver to individuals. **FOR SAFETY REASONS, nothing may be thrown from the floats.** Safety is of utmost importance with big machinery, horses, automobiles, and floats.
5. **EQUIPMENT DEALERS are asked to limit the amount of equipment to 2 pieces of machinery. If the machinery is over 12ft wide 4 spotters must walk with the piece of equipment. If the machinery is less than 12ft wide, no spotters are required. If you would like to have more entered in the parade, contact the Ag & Ex management. Provide the *Names of your volunteer spotters:***


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6. Promotional pamphlets of any description must not be handed out or otherwise distributed along the parade route.
7. All horses must assemble in the grassed ditch along the North parking lot of the Credit Union i-plex. Attendants will direct you on where to go. This does not apply to horses pulling floats.
8. **To avoid congestion, only registered entry vehicles will be allowed in the “Parade Assembly Area” (Credit Union i-plex’s North parking lot) until 8:30AM. ALL OTHER VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED IN THE CREDIT UNION i- PLEX’S SOUTH PARKING LOT AFTER 8:30AM. If you need to complete decorating your float, please park in the Curling Rink parking lot (parking lot at the main doors of the i-plex) to do this, and then head over to the East entrance of the parking lot (Hwy #4 entrance). PLEASE DO THIS BEFORE 8:30AM. NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE NORTH PARKING LOT AFTER 8:30AM. There will be attendance with golf carts to drive people (and any decorations they may have) to their floats after 8:30am. \*\*See attached map of the Credit Union i-plex’s Parking lot\*\*.**
9. Parade entry forms must be received by Friday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Last minute entries will be accommodated, if possible, but may be inserted at the rear of the parade.
10. The committee reserves the right to reject or position at the end of the parade any entries other than Agriculture equipment, antiques, restored items that do not have decorations, signage or theme presentations.
11. Parade entrants are responsible for the care and control of any animals entered and the safe handling of all items entered including, but not limited to, steering, braking, and safe construction and safety maintenance.

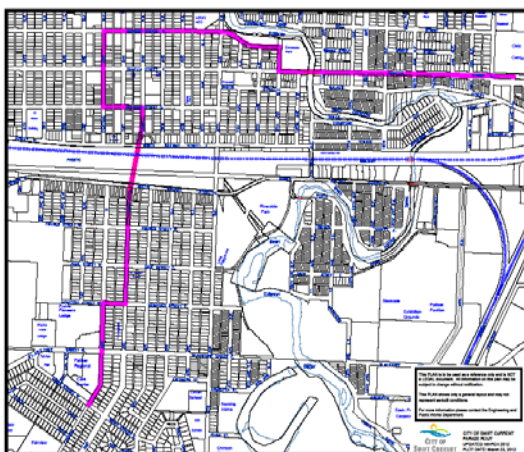


#### CREDIT UNION i-PLEX PARKING LOT

If you need to complete decorating your float, please park in the Curling Rink Parking Lot (parking lot at the main doors of the i-Plex) to do this. Once this is done please head over to the East Entrance of the parking lot (Hwy #4 entrance) PLEASE DO THIS BEFORE 8:30AM.

**NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CREDIT UNION i-PLEX'S NORTH PARKING LOT AFTER 8:30AM!!!** There will be attendance with golf carts to drive people (and any decorations they may have) to their floats after 8:30am.

 West on Chaplin St.  
 North on 9th Ave N.E. (Elmwood Park)  
 West on Herbert St. (Swift Current Shrine Club Hall)  
 South on Central Ave N. (Post Office)  
 East on Cheadle St. (Sub Way)  
 South on 2nd Ave N.E. (Over pass)  
 West on McIntosh St. (South end of St. Joe's School)  
 South on Central Ave S. (Prairie Pioneer Lodge)  
 Parade ends at Gibbs St. (South end of the former Palliser Regional Care Centre)
