2023 PARADE INFORMATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS

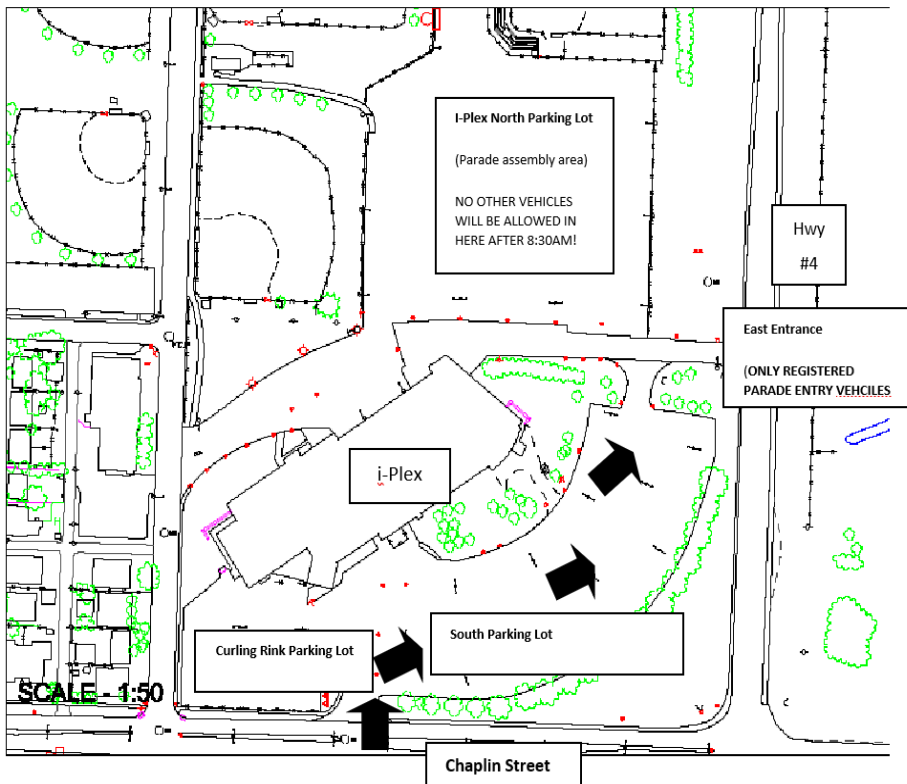
1. The parade assembly area is located in the Innovation Credit Union iPlex North parking lot. Floats and other parade entries **MUST** enter at the Main entrance of the iPlex parking lot (Chaplin Street) and then head over to the East entrance of the parking lot (Hwy #4). Attendants will be present to direct you to your designated location.
2. Entries for judging must be in position at the iPlex North parking lot by 7:45 AM, June 29, 2024. Late arrivals will not be judged.
3. The parade will commence at 10:00 AM SHARP.
4. If you would like to distribute promotional materials, candy, balloons, or other treats along the parade route, persons walking beside your entry must hand deliver to individuals. **FOR SAFETY REASONS, nothing may be thrown from the floats**. Safety is of utmost importance with big machinery, horses, automobiles, and floats.
5. Water guns or hoses may not be sprayed directly into the crowd.
6. EQUIPMENT DEALERS are asked to limit the amount of equipment to 2 pieces of machinery. If the machinery is over 12ft wide, 4 spotters must walk with the piece of equipment. If the machinery is less than 12ft wide, no spotters are required. If you would like to have more entered in the parade, contact the Swift Current Ag & Ex management.

7. Promotional pamphlets of any description must not be handed out or otherwise distributed along the parade route. This includes any and all religious or political materials.
8. All horses must assemble in the grassed ditch along the North parking lot of the iPlex. Attendants will direct you on where to go. This does not apply to horses pulling floats.
9. **To avoid congestion, only registered entry vehicles will be allowed in the “Parade Assembly Area” (iPlex North parking lot) until 8:30 AM. ALL OTHER VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED IN THE IPLEX SOUTH PARKING LOT AFTER 8:30 AM.** If you need to complete decorating your float, please park in the Curling Rink parking lot (parking lot at the main doors of the iPlex) to do this, and then head over to the East entrance of the parking lot (Hwy #4 entrance). **PLEASE DO THIS BEFORE 8:30 AM. NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE NORTH PARKING LOT AFTER 8:30 AM.** There will be attendance with golf carts to drive people (and any decorations they may have) to their floats after 8:30 AM. *See attached map of the iPlex’s Parking lot *
10. Parade entry forms must be received by Monday June, 3rd, 2024. Last minute entries will be accommodated, if possible, but may be inserted at the end of the parade.
11. The committee reserves the right to reject or position at the end of the parade any entries other than Agriculture equipment, antiques, restored items that do not have decorations, signage or theme presentations.
12. Parade entrants are responsible for the care and control of any animals entered and the safe handling of all items entered including, but not limited to, steering, braking, and safe construction and safety maintenance.
13. Prizes are as follows: Grand Award Winner – Trophy plus \$150.00; Best Depicting Theme – Trophy plus \$100; Best Commercial/Business Entry – 1st Prize \$100, 2nd Prize \$50; Best Community/Volunteer/Non-Profit Entry – 1st Prize \$100, 2nd Prize \$50; Best Junior Organization/4-H Club Entry – 1st Prize \$100, 2nd Prize \$50; Best Decorated Horse & Rider Entry – 1st Prize \$100, 2nd Prize \$50; Best Decorated Heavy Horse Wagon/Chuckwagon Entry – 1st Prize \$100, 2nd Prize \$50; Antiques Entry – 1st Prize \$100, 2nd Prize \$50; and Best Cultural Entry – 1st Prize \$100, 2nd Prize \$50.

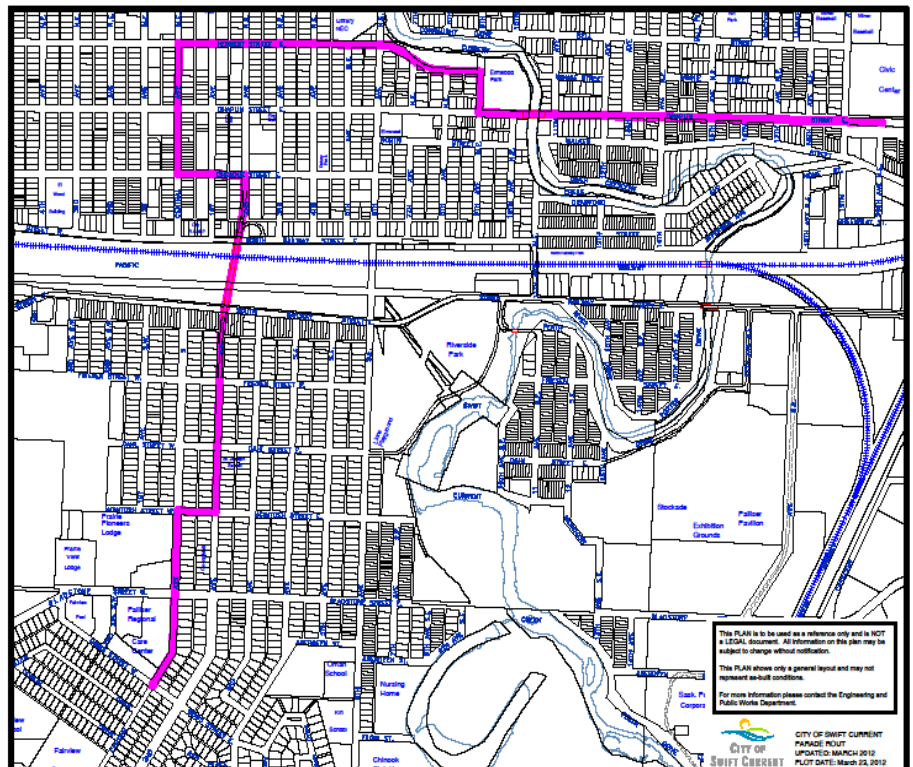

- North on 9th Ave N.E. (Elmwood Park)
- West on Herbert St. (Swift Current Shrine Club Hall)
- South on Central Ave N. (Post Office)
- East on Cheadle St. (Subway)
- South on 2nd Ave N.E. (Overpass)
- West on McIntosh St.
- South on Central Ave S. (Prairie Pioneer Lodge)
- Parade end on Gibbs St. (South end of Plewis Automotive Group Inclusive Park)
